2/28/2019	I	DRI	Your horse has had an episode of colic. Colic is a broad term which covers any type of abdominal pain, it is not a specific diagnosis. Most cases of mild colic are treated symptomatically with resolution of the problem without a specific diagnosis. If the initial treatment fails to take care of the problem, more extensive diagnostics are in order. The physical examination findings for your horse include evidence of abdominal pain: pawing, rolling, not eating, and restlessness. Pulse is 48, respiration is normal, color is normal with a capillary refill time of under 3 seconds, which is within normal limits, temperature is 99, and gut motility is diminished. A rectal examination was not done due to safety considerations. The horse was given the following treatments: a stomach tube was passed to check for reflux; no reflux was present; mineral oil and water was pumped into the stomach. The horse was given an IV injection of Banamine which is a good pain medication for colic pain. Aftercare at home includes monitoring for continued colicky behavior. If the colic should get worse, please contact us immediately. If your horse wants to lie down and quietly rest, that is fine.
